


3" RolaCage User Guide

Introduction

The RolaCage allows 3" diameter masts of up to 7m in height to be deployed smoothly and easily. The mast is inserted loose into the cage. The design does not need a central spindle. Deploy to the required length and lock the retaining plate using the wing screw. Ensure that:

- 1. About a metre is still left inside the cage
- 2. The base of the cage is secured with pegs
- 3. The RolaCage is securely locked with the central screw

Deploying the RolaTube

 Remove the retaining pin that holds the top two bars in place



2. Slide out the top two bars





3. Insert the mast ensuring that it will exit through the larger gap between the bars, then reposition the top two bars and replace the retaining pins.



4. Unroll mast to the required length (ensuring 1m is kept in the RolaCage), then tighten the wing screw on the side as this applies the brake and keeps the mast in position.
